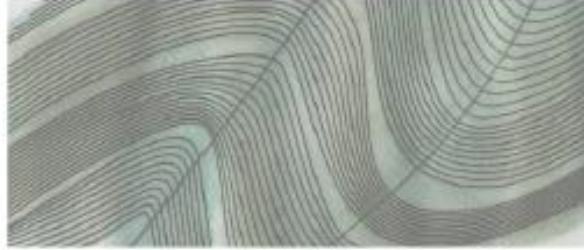

2007 Wrecked Shiraz

Nashwauk vineyard overlooks the coast of the Fleurieu Peninsula & the township of McLaren Vale. It takes its name from a ship, the Nashwauk, which was wrecked of the nearby coast on May 13th 1855. The design on our label depicts the contours and valleys of our vineyard, located in the Seaview sub region of McLaren Vale.

Fruit was selected from two separate blocks on the Nashwauk property, vines range from 20 & 40 years of age.

Fermentation for seven days on skins. Both parcels were kept separate until final blending. Matured for 15 months in new (40%) and one year old (60%) French oak barriques.

Deep violet colour. Dark berry fruits with an elegant palate, fine tannins of fruit and oak.

Estate grown.
350 cases produced.
