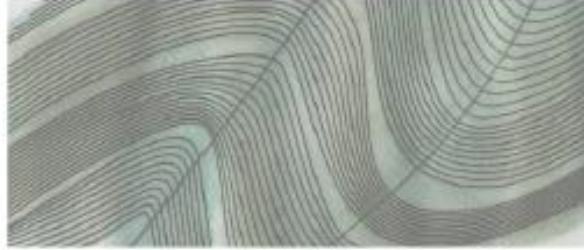

Nashwauk vineyard overlooks the coast of the Fleurieu Peninsula & the township of McLaren Vale. It takes its name from a ship, the Nashwauk, which was wrecked on the nearby coast on May 13th 1855. The design on our label depicts the contours and valleys of our vineyard, located in the Seaview sub region of McLaren Vale.

Fermented in open fermenters for 5 days, hand plunged three times a day. Basket pressed into two and three year old French barrels. 15 months oak maturation.

This wine has a perfumed floral lift with savoury, earthy tones, subtle saddle leather characters mixed with dark cherries. An awesome food wine especially tapas dishes.

Estate grown.
